Minutes of Annual General Meeting 2023

- 1. Members approved it is not necessary to join the Hong Kong Laser Class Championship or Port Shelter Regatta to become a member of the association.
- 2. Previous financial statement presented and approved. Previous AGM minutes circulated and approved.
- 3. The current President presented a verbal report of the activities of the Class since the last meeting. In summary:
 - As HKLCA previously included membership in conjunction with the Nationals entry fee this year we
 - learned who our members are, how to reach them we have 50 members!
 - Held the first stand alone nationals event in a decade.
 - The 2023 Laser Class Championships had 38 entrants across the 3 classes
- HKLCA Ranking system (high points) and the differentiation of HKSF ranking system (Racing Rules of Sailing, low points) explained. HKLCA ranks all ILCA member sailors for ILCA events. HKSF has different criteria and ranks for national team and funding support.

- 6. Additional HKLCA ranking event at HHYC (HHYC Open Dinghy Regatta) has been proposed and approved for the 2023/2024 season.
